Kiro Report of the emergency fund:

We thank KJG for this financial support which means your friendship, solidarity and love. This fund allows us to give relief services in the refugee's camps, to support people who were victims of the 12 January earthquake and specially kiro members. We also have to support the Port-au-Prince kiro diocesan committee that lost all his office and belongings. We received also funds

from other organizations and we could help many people in the refugee's camps, in the local kiro groups where there were needs in food, drinks, medical care, and especially in Port-au-Prince, Leogane and Jacmel. Up to now, we keep on helping out people looking for the best ways to prepare kiro members to be more present among them and to share solidarity and friendship with them.

Our most relief activities:

- We could organize a first gathering with all kiro members in Port-au-Prince after the January 12 earthquake, especially on march 30, 2010. Many kiros members could meet each other in order to remember the ones who died and to move on with kiros activities.
- We could assist many kiros members in the earlier hours after the earthquake with tents, food, drinks, caps, etc., in Port-au-Prince, Cabaret, Petit Goave, Grand Goave, Leogane, Jacmel.
- We could buy an electric generator to the functioning of our National Secretary. This allowed us to publish a 2,500 twonpèt (Kiro magazine) in order to inform kiro members about the eartquake's consequences and to encourage them to go back to kiro activities: meetings, visiting kiros families, taking care of kiros members victims.
- We organized 10 special bivouacs in all the dioceses for kiro monitors about the January earthquake with geologist, psychologist, to help them know better the different movements of the earth and especially what they had to do in order to go through the earthquake problems and to help other people to do so.
- We trained 100 kiros people in Port-au-Prince (Léogane), Jacmel and Cayes so they could be more effective in sharing food, drinks, soaps in the refugee's camps, learning people out to keep their tents clean. They're talking and praying with these people, making animation activities and games for the children, organizing Christmas feast with children in the refugee's camps.
- Kiro members helped in repairing shelters in the refugee's camps to protect people from sun, rain and floods. We provided them with carpets, covers, blankets, wood, etc.
- In all the dioceses, we organized activities with the people who left Port-au-Prince after the 12 January earthquake in the occasion of the diocesan celebrations of 50 years of Kiro: activities and games with the children and talks and visits to many families.
- We assisted financially the medical care of many kiros who got injuried in the 12 January Earthquake.
- We helped some families to repair as well as possible their houses and to leave the refugee's camps.
- We assisted many kiro members to pay their scholarship especially the ones who had lost their parents or tutors.
- We have trained 500 kiros members and involved in the campaign against cholera in Port-au-Prince. Kiros members could with megaphones, give some advices and instructions on how people could prevent themselves from cholera. We provided people with chlorine, soaps, and other disinfectants. Kiros members did this campaign against

cholera in the refugee's camps, in the public markets, churches, school, from houses to houses, in the remote areas. Kiros could also share flyers received from the ministries of Youth, Health and Civilian protection.

- Presently we have 100 kiros members participating in building houses (in wood) with a GNO called "**Un techo para mi pais**" in Cabaret(northern part of Port-au-Prince) for homeless people.
- The next step of our relief activities is to identify more or less 100 people who need help for running their small business, medical care, scholarship, repairing their houses. For that, we have made an inquiry about the situation of people before and after the 12 January Earthquake.
- We have actually 20 kiros members in Port-au-Prince, Leogane and Jacmel whose houses need to be repaired or built. We are looking for material and financial supports. We still have to evaluate the costs of works.
- We could not help running the Port-au-Prince diocesan kiro committee to have a new office because the archdiocese offices are not yet built. Meanwhile, we are sharing Kiro National Secretary Services with the Board of the diocesan Kiro committee of Port-au-Prince (they are looking now for an office to rent).
- We will do our best to keeping on providing people in need with our relief intervention trying to train and sustain kiro members involved in this program. We will give a complete and detailed report at the end of this current fiscal year (September, 30, 2011).
- We also received a land from the State to build a formation youth center. We're waiting for propriety documents to make plans for its construction.
- We added the kiro financial report from January 2010 to February 211. This will help to see different sections related to our relief services.
